**AN ORDINANCE TO ORGANIZE TRAFFIC AROUND THE  
HIGH SCHOOL AND JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS**

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council of the City of Nokomis, to provide for the protection of the school children and citizens a more cohesive flow of traffic around the campus.

WHEREAS, it is understood that school personnel will be responsible for the loading and unloading of children and the crossing areas at North Walnut Street and Memorial Park Drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS,

1. North Walnut Street from Oberle Street to Weaver Street shall be one way traffic only from North to South on school days from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
2. Memorial Park Drive from North Cedar Street to North Walnut Street shall be one way traffic from East to West on school days from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
3. This ordinance shall be effective November 1, 2015.
4. Any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be fined not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), nor more than Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) for any on offense.

Passed by a majority vote of the members of the City Council and approved by the Mayor of the City of Nokomis, Illinois on this 12th day of October, 2015.


**CERTIFICATION**
