Commissioner Glenn then stated he would like to present the pre-employment contract to the officer to see if he would agree to it.

Commissioner Stauder addressed to the council the possibility of putting in a charging station for electric cars. Discussion was then had on whether or not it would be worth it and where the nearest charging location is at.

Commissioner Glenn made a motion to approve a fence permit at 624 School St. Commissioner Durbin seconded the motion. Voting yes, Commissioners Stauder, Glenn and Durbin. Nays none, the motion carried.

Commissioner Glenn made a motion to approve a fence permit at 130 Stevens St. Commissioner Durbin seconded the motion. Voting yes, Commissioners Stauder, Glenn and Durbin. Nays none. The motion carried.

Commissioner Glenn made a motion to approve a park permit for Trent West to hold a Farmers Market at Fred B. Johnson Park. Commissioner Durbin seconded the motion. Voting yes, Commissioners Stauder, Glenn and Durbin. Nays none, the motion carried

The Council agreed to put the liquor license on the next regular meeting agenda for discussion.
