## AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 24-6-11 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE CODE OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Illinois, that:

The Motor Vehicle Code of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Nokomis, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

- **24-6-11** <u>SEMI-TRACTORS AND SEMI-TRAILERS</u> All semi-tractors and semi-trailers are banned from parking on any streets or alleys within the city limits except for deliveries, which parking shall be only for so long as is necessary to accomplish said delivery.
- 1. The City has established a parking area for semi-tractors and semi-trailers, and all said semi-tractors and semi-trailers shall park on the designated parking lot at the rear of the Nokomis City Hall in the designated parking places only. All trailers shall be backed up to, but no further than the existing posts or barrier.
- 2. All drivers shall register with the dispatcher, giving all information required by the dispatcher including but not limited to license plate numbers, driver identification, owner, lessee and employer. The driver shall further declare and specify all hazardous substances which are contained within the trailer.
  - 3. All drivers shall proceed in and out of the parking area as follows:

IN: Turn West off Cedar Street between railroad tracks and shed proceed to parking area. OUT: proceed East between railroad tracks and shed to Cedar Street thence South to State Street.

- 4. In the event the tractor or trailer is not parked appropriately within the marked parking area, the tractor and or trailer shall be towed and the owner, lessee, lessor and operator shall be liable for all towing costs as well as fines and court costs provided herein
- 5. The penalty for violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be a fine of not less than **One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)** nor more than **Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)** for each violation thereof. Each day of the violation shall constitute a separate offense. Said offense shall be a business offense, and shall be enforceable against the owner, lessee, lessor, and operator of said equipment.
