ORDINANCE NO. 973

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 21 ARTICLE II OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Illinois that,

Chapter 21 Article II, Section 6, paragraphs (A) and (B) of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Nokomis, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

- (A) <u>Class "A" License.</u> A Class "A" License shall authorize the retail sale on the premises specified of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises as well as other retail sales such as liquor. The quarterly license fee shall be **One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00)** and shall be paid in advance. Sunday's sales will be included. No more than **five (5) licenses** shall be issued at any one time (**Ord. No. 848; 06-08-98)**
- (B) <u>Class "B" License</u> A Class "B" License shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquor in the sealed packages, but not for consumption on the premises. The quarterly license fee shall be **One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars** (\$125.00) payable in advance. No more than three (3) licenses shall be issued at any one time. Sunday sales will be included. (Ord. No. 848; 06-08-98)
