AN ORDINANCE AMENDING and ADDING TO SECTION 38-4-33 of the REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Illinois that:

Section 38-4-33 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Nokomis is amended as follows:

- **38–4–33** <u>USER CHARGE SYSTEM</u> The following rates are established for the User Charge System:
 - (A) <u>User Rate</u> All users of the Wastewater Facilities of the City shall pay a minimum monthly bill of Four Dollars and Seventy-Five cents (\$4.75) per billing period for users inside the City limits or Nine Dollars and Seventy-Five cents (\$9.75) per billing period for users outside the City limits for each connection to the system. The purpose of this minimum bill is to recover the fixed overhead costs associated with operating and maintaining the City sewer system. (Ord. No. 834; 03-24-97)
 - (B) <u>Inside City</u> \$4.65 per 1,000 gallons per month beginning July 1, 2013 (on bills having a due date of August 15, 2013)
 - (C) <u>Outside City</u> \$6.30 per 1,000 gallons per month beginning July 1, 2013 (on bills having a due date of August 15, 2013)
 - (D) Village of Coalton \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons per month beginning May 1, 2002
