

ORDINANCE NO. 439

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CERTAIN TURNS AT CERTAIN STREET INTERSECTIONS IN THE  
CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Illinois:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to drive his or their automobile, motorcycle, or other motor vehicle, or to so turn said automobile, motorcycle, or other motor vehicle, so as to proceed in the opposite direction to which he has been going along the same street, at the intersection of State and Elm streets; at the intersection of State and Oak streets; at the intersection of State and Maple streets; at the intersection of State and Spruce streets; at the intersection of State and Pine streets; and at the intersection of State and Cedar streets; all in said City of Nokomis and State of Illinois.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Three Dollars (\$3.00) nor more than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Whereas this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public health and safety, an emergency for its immediate passage and taking effect is hereby declared to exist and it shall therefore take effect from and after its passage, signing, recording and publication pursuant to law.
