

ORDINANCE NO. 470

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE HAULING,
CONVEYING OR TRANSPORTING OF GARBAGE,
JUNK, DEAD ANIMALS, WASTE AND REFUSE
ON PUBLIC HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CITY
LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery
County, Illinois:

SECTION I

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to haul,
convey or otherwise transport any garbage, junk, dead animals, waste or refuse
of any kind or nature upon any public street, public alley or public passageway
within the city limits of the City of Nokomis, unless such garbage, junk, dead
animals, waste or refuse shall be hauled or conveyed or transported in any
vehicle whether the same be motor driven, horse drawn or hand drawn and on
the bed of said vehicle hauling, conveying or transporting the same shall be
completely and solidly enclosed with wood or metal.

SECTION II

Any person, firm or corporation violating the terms of this Ordinance
shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred
Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.

This Ordinance shall be in effect immediately after its passage and
publication according to law.
