

ORDINANCE NO. 472

AN ORDINANCE STATING THAT SOUTH WALNUT STREET IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, SHALL BE A DEAD END STREET AND NO PERSON SHALL ENTER SAID STREET FROM STATE ROUTE NO. 16 IN SAID CITY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois;

SECTION I

That South Walnut Street in the City of Nokomis, shall be a dead end street and no person shall leave nor enter said street from State Route No. 16 in said City of Nokomis.

SECTION II

Any person who shall leave or enter South Walnut Street in the City of Nokomis from State Route No. 16 in said City of Nokomis, said South Walnut Street in the City of Nokomis, being a dead end street, shall for each offense be fined in the sum of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall be in effect immediately after its passage and publication according to law.
