

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS

FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING ON THE 30TH DAY OF APRIL, A.D. 1963.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Illinois;

SECTION 1. That the following sums be and the same are hereby appropriated out of the revenue of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, State of Illinois, for the fiscal year ending the 30th day of April, A.D. 1963, and the specific objects and purposes for which said sums are appropriated in detail are as follows:

1. For Street and Alley Fund Apportioned as follows:

(a) To be used for construction of streets and alleys	\$ 1,000.00
(b) For Repairing and improving streets and alleys.	5,000.00
(c) For Repairing and improving sidewalks and crossings	1,000.00
(d) For constructing bridges	1,000.00
(e) For repairing bridges	2,000.00
(f) For oiling streets and alleys.	3,500.00
TOTAL	<u>\$ 13,500.00</u>

2. For a Salary Fund to be used to pay the salaries of the City officers and employees excepting firemen, policemen and employees engaged in the maintenance and operation of the water works system. \$ 25,000.00

3. For a Salary Fund for Policemen to be used to pay salaries of the policemen \$ 13,000.00

4. For an Electric Fund to be used to pay for lighting the streets and alleys. \$ 5,100.00

5. For Water Works Fund: For the acquisition and construction of addition, improvements, and extensions to maintenance, repair and operation of the water works system of said City, including water supply, together with all necessary labor, materials, supplies, superintendence, professional services, salaries of superintendent and employees, furnishings, equipment and supplies, expense of meter reading, delivery of bills and collection of water accounts and miscellaneous expense. \$ 16,000.00

6. For a Fire Department fund apportioned as follows:

(a) To be used in paying the firemen.	\$ 1,000.00
(b) For the purchase of equipment for the use of the fire department.	1,000.00
(c) For the purchase of supplies for the use of the fire department.	1,000.00
(d) For repair and maintenance of equipment used by the fire department.	<u>1,000.00</u>
	<u>\$ 4,000.00</u>

7. For a City Prisoner Fund to be used for feeding the prisoners of said City. \$ 100.00

8. For a Printing and Stationery Fund:

(a) Printing	\$ 300.00
(b) Postage	150.00
(c) Stationery	<u>150.00</u>
	<u>\$ 600.00</u>

9. For a City Park Fund to be used for labor and maintenance of the City Park. \$ 300.00

10. For a City Hall Fund apportioned as follows:

(a) Audit Expense.	\$ 400.00
(b) Maintenance of City Hall	500.00
(c) Furniture and supplies of City Hall.	500.00
(d) Heating City Hall	500.00
(e) Repair of City Hall	1,000.00
(f) Telephones.	300.00
TOTAL	<u>\$ 3,200.00</u>

11. For a Public Health and Safety Fund to be used for the payment of expenses of caring for public health of the inhabitants of said City, under the supervision of the Department of Public Health and Safety. \$ 1,000.00

12. For an Election Fund, apportioned as follows:

(a) Printing ballots and election notices.	\$ 100.00
(b) Rent of Poling Places.	50.00
(c) Purchase of Election supplies.	50.00
(d) Salaries, Judges and Clerks	200.00
TOTAL	<u>\$ 400.00</u>

13. For a Sewer Fund, apportioned as follows:

(a) To be used for the construction of sewers and drains. . . \$ 2,000.00	
(b) For the maintenance of sewers and drains. \$ 2,000.00	
TOTAL	<u>\$ 4,000.00</u>

14. For Bonded Indebtedness Fund, apportioned as follows:

(a) Paying the Indebtedness of said City and interest thereon as provided by Ordinance No. 437. \$ 6,600.00

15. For an Insurance and Bond Premium Fund apportioned as follows:

(a) Insurance Premiums on City Property.	\$ 1,500.00
(b) Surety Policy and Compensation Insurance.	1,500.00
TOTAL	<u>\$ 3,000.00</u>

16. For a Public Benefit Fund to be used for the payment of assessments for public benefits against the City. \$ 1,000.00

17. For a Federal Old Age and Survivor's Insurance System Fund. \$ 2,500.00

SECTION 2. That the sums of money appropriated by the provisions of this ordinance total Ninety Nine Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$99,300.00).

SECTION 3. That any unexpended balance of any items of any appropriations made by this ordinance may be expended in making up any insufficiency in any other items of appropriations made by this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, as provided by law, from and after its final passage, approval and publication.
