

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TILE USED IN THE  
CONSTRUCTION OF DRIVEWAYS AND ALL TILE USED  
TO CLOSE OPEN DITCHES IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS,  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County,  
Illinois, that,

SECTION 1. Any person, firm or corporation who shall desire to use tile  
in the construction of a driveway in the said City of Nokomis shall use tile in the same  
of reinforced lock joint concrete or galvanized steel, and any person, firm or corporation  
who shall desire to close open ditches in said City of Nokomis shall use tile of glazed  
bell tile, concrete lock joint tile or galvanized steel and said tile so used shall be  
sufficient to carry the flow of water.

SECTION 11. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions  
of this ordinance shall be fined a sum of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more  
than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each violation thereof and each and every day  
said violation is continued shall constitute a new and separate offense.
