

ORDINANCE NO. 546  
AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BURNING  
OF CERTAIN MATERIALS IN THE CITY OF  
NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery  
County, Illinois, that:

SECTION 1

It shall be unlawful at any time hereafter for any person, firm or  
corporation to burn any substance or materials in the City of Nokomis, Montgomery  
County, Illinois, excepting paper, cardboard, dry vegetation and heating fuels,  
provided however, paper, cardboard and dry vegetation shall be burned only between  
sunrise and sunset of any day.

SECTION 11

That any Ordinance or portion thereof of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery  
County, Illinois, now in full force and effect in conflict with this Ordinance  
is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 111

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this  
Ordinance shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One  
Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.
