

ORDINANCE NO. 601

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OPEN LEWDNESS, AND
VIOLENT, OFFENSIVE AND DISORDERLY CONDUCT IN THE CITY
OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY,
ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION 1

Whoever shall within the limits of the City of Nokomis be guilty of open
lewdness or any violent, offensive or disorderly conduct, or who shall disturb
the peace any any exhibition, theatre, lecture or other place of amusement or
entertainment or at any election poll or school, shall, upon conviction be fined
any sum not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Two Hundred dollars
(\$200.00), for each violation thereof.

SECTION 11

Any ordinance or ordinances of said City of Nokomis now in conflict with this
ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 111

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage,
approval and publication according to law.
