

ORDINANCE NO. 625

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF
VEHICLES ON THE STREETS OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS, WHILE
MAKING LOUD OR UNNECESSARY NOISE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY,
ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION I

It shall be unlawful to operate a vehicle which makes an unusually
loud or unnecessary noise on the streets of Nokomis, Illinois.

SECTION II

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of
this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor
more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION III

Any ordinance or ordinances of said City of Nokomis now in conflict with
this ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its
passage, approval and publication according to law.
