

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TRAFFICING OF CERTAIN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY PERSONS OF THE AGE OF 19 YEARS AND UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS, IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION I. It shall be lawful for any person of the age of nineteen (19) years and under the age of twenty-one (21) years to transport by motor vehicle or otherwise within the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois, beer and/or wine in the original package with the seal unbroken in the said City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois.

SECTION II. Any person violating any provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined a sum not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION III. Any ordinance or ordinances of said City of Nokomis, now in conflict with this ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, according to law.
