

ORDINANCE NO. 651

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF  
MOTOR VEHICLES ~~PASSING THROUGH~~ THE CITY OF  
NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOI

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY,  
ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION 1

No person, firm, or corporation shall operate any motor vehicle, motorcycle, or motor bike within the limits of the City of Nokomis at a speed greater than twenty-five (25) miles per hour unless said motor vehicle, motorcycle, or motor bike shall be operated within an area of said City of Nokomis where a sign provides for a greater or lesser speed than twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

SECTION 11

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 111

Any ordinance or ordinances of said City of Nokomis now in conflict with this ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 1V

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
