SUCCESTED CITY/VILLAGE ORDINANCE No. 667

RELATING TO EMERGENCY SERVICES AND

DISASTER AGENCIES (ESDA)

PREPARED BY STATE EMERGENCY SERVICES AND DISASTER AGENCY

An Ordinance Relating to City/VIXIARE ESDA

BE IT ORDAINED by the (Mayor) (William expression of the (City) (Workinger) of Nokomis that: (Establishment) There is hereby created Nokomis Section 1. ESDA to prevent, minimize, repair, and alleviate injury or damage resulting from disaster caused by enemy attack, sabotage, or other hostile action, or from natural or man-made disaster, in accordance with "The Illinois Emergency Services and Disaster Act of 1975". This ESDA shall consists of the Deputy County Coordinator and such additional members as may Nokomis be selected by him. (Deputy County Coordinator) The Deputy County Coordinato Section 2. for Nokomis shall be appointed by the (Mayor) same. The Deputy County Coordinator for Nokomis have direct responsibility for the organization, administration, training, and operation of the ESDA, subject to the direction and control of the (Mayor)

> In the event of the absence, resignation, death or inability to serve as the Deputy County Coordinator for Nokomis , the (Mayor) (William XX President) or any person designated by him, shall be and act as Deputy County Coordinator for Nokomis until a new appointment is made as provided in this ordinance.

Section 3. ESDA functions within the (City) (WXXXXXXXX) as shall be prescribed in and by the state ESDA plan and program oprepared by the Governor, and such orders, rules and

regulations as may be promulgated by the Governor, and in addition shall perform such duties outside the corporate limits as may be required pursuant to any Mutual Aid agreement with any other political subdivision, municipality, or quasimunicipality entered into as provided the "The State ESDA Act of 1975".

Section 4.

(Service as Mobile Support Team) All or any members of the (City) (Williage) ESDA organization may be designated as members of a Mobile Support Team created by the director of the State ESDA as provided by law.

The leader of such Mobile Support Team shall be designated by the Deputy County Coordinator of the (City) (VXXIVEGE) ESDA organization.

Section 5.

(Agreements with other political subdivisions) The Deputy County Coordinator for Nokomis of ESDA may negotiate Mutual Aid Agreements with other cities or political subdivisions of the state, but no such agreement shall be effective until it has been approved by the (Mayor) (William Expression and by the state director of ESDA.

Section 6.

(Compensation) Members of the ESDA who are paid employees or officers of the (City) (XXXXXXXX), if called for training by the state director of ESDA, shall receive for the time spent in such training the same rate of pay as is attached to the position held; members who are

Section 8.

(Reimbursement by State) The State Treasurer may receive and allocate to the appropriate fund, any reimbursement by the state to the (City) (Withdrage) for expenses incident to training members of the ESDA as prescribed by the State Director of ESDA, compensation for services and expenses of members of a Mobile Support Team while serving outside the (City) (WIXINGEX) in response to a call by the Governor or State Director of ESDA, as provided by law, and any other reimbursement made by the state incident to ESDA activities as provided by law.

Section 9.

In the event of enemy caused or other disaster, the Deputy County Coordinator for Nokomis of ESDA is authorized, on behalf of the (City) (Vilver), to procure such services, supplies, equipment or material as may be necessary for such purposes, in view of the exigency without regard to the statutory procedures or formalities normally prescribed by law pertaining to (City) (Virious) contracts or obligations, as authorized by "The State ESDA Act of 1975", provided that if the (Mayor) (Virious Presidents) meets at such time he shall act subject to the directions and restrictions imposed by that body.

Section 10.

(Oath) Every person appointed to serve in any capacity in the (City) (Yithway) ESDA organization shall, before entering upon his duties, subscribe to the following oath, which shall be filed with the Deputy County Coordinator for ________:

"I, _______, do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support and defend and bear true faith and allegiance to the Constitution of the United

States and the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the territory, institutions, and facilities thereof, both public and private, against all enemies, foreign and domestic; that I take this obligation freely, without any mental reservation or purpose of evasion; and that I will well and faithfully discharge the duties upon which I am about to enter. And I do further swear (or affirm) that I do not advocate, nor am I nor have I been a member of any political party or organization that advocates the overthrow of the government of the United States or of this State by force or violence; and that during such time as I am affiliated with the Nokomis ESDA organization, I will not advocate nor become a member of any political party or organization that advocates the overthrow of the government of the United States or of this State by force or violence."

- Section 11.
- (Office) The (Mayor) (WikkagexPresident) is authorized to designate space in a (City) (Wikkagex) building, or elsewhere, as may be provided for by the (Mayor) (WikkagexXPresident) for the (City) (Wikkage) ESDA as its office.
- Section 12.
- (Appropriation Levy of Taxes) The (Mayor) (WINNAME RESTRICTION) may make an appropriation for ESDA purposes in the manner provided by law, and may levy in addition for ESDA purposes only, a tax not to exceed five (5) cents per one hundred (100) dollars of the assessed value of all taxable property in addition to all other taxes, as provided by the "The State ESDA Act of 1975"; however, that amount collectable under such levy shall in no event exceed .25 cents per capita.
- Section 13. (Definition) E.S.D.A. This abbreviation means unless otherwise defined, "Emergency Services and Disaster Agency.
- Section 14. (Equal Employment Opportunity Clause) The (City) (Widdleser) agrees to the Equal Employment Opportunity Clause required by the Illinois Fair Employment Practices Commission on all public contracts.
- Section 15. (Repeal of Nokomis Civil Defense Ordinance
 The Nokomis Civil Defense Ordinance
 No. 556 dated and approved 12/5/66
 as amended is repealed.

Section 16.	This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and approval, as provided by law.
