

ORDINANCE NO. 689

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 656 ✓
BEING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC AT THE
INTERSECTION OF SOUTH MAPLE STREET AND SOUTH STREET,
IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS;
THAT:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 656 heretofore enacted by the City Council
of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois, on the 13th day of January,
A.D. 1975, stating that all traffic on South Street, traveling in a northeasterly or
southwesterly direction, shall stop before entering the intersection at South Maple
Street in said City of Nokomis, is hereby repealed.
