

ORDINANCE NO. 802

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STOPSIGNS  
IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS

WHEREAS the mayor and the commissioners of the City of Nokomis, following a detailed consideration of a citizens' petition for stopsigns at the intersection of Walnut and Franklin Streets in the City of Nokomis, have concluded that the public health and safety of motorists and pedestrians in the said City require the placement of the requested stopsigns pursuant to §24-3-5 of the "Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois",

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS:

Section 1: That the below-described intersection is hereby designated a "four-way stop" intersection, and stopsigns shall forthwith be erected for all streets intersecting there:

W. Walnut Street at W. Franklin Street

Section 2: (Partial Invalidity): That if any section, subdivision, sentence or clause of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, according to law.
